
## Living Traditions

"J' can't dance," George admitted embarrassed.


Once the bride and groom had said their "J do's" the guests congratulated them and headed for the reception hall.

George's mother had always wanted a daughter, and she really liked the way Selina helped her son.


Selina also helped around the house with various chores, even with the difficult job of harvesting olives in the fall.

With his mother's encouragement he asked for Selina's hand in marriage.


Selina said, "Yes! Yes! Yes!"
